

## At what age do boys get started?

Pack 334 welcomes boys in 1<sup>st</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> Grade to work with their Den (age group) to achieve each rank.

- **Bobcat** – All boys first work to achieve this rank for the basics of Cub Scouting. 1<sup>st</sup> Graders will work on this together. If you son is joining after 1<sup>st</sup> Grade, this is the only “catch up” requirement to achieve.
- **Tiger** – 1<sup>st</sup> Grade boys will work together to complete the Bobcat and Tiger ranks in their first year of scouting. They will discuss healthy lifestyles, teamwork, and explore the world around them.
- **Wolf** – 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade boys work together to complete the Wolf rank. In addition to building on the Tiger requirements, boys will further their outdoor skills and as well as STEM topics.
- **Bear** - 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade boys explore life skills with their Den to prepare to be self-reliant and further their outdoor knowledge.
- **Webelos** – 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Grade boys will progress with their Den for two years as a Webelo to prepare for the transition to Boy Scouts with wilderness exploration. In 5<sup>th</sup> Grade they will “graduate” from Cub Scouts and decide how they would like to continue their scouting journey with a Boy Scout Troop.

## What can I expect this to cost?

- Annual dues are \$100 for returning Scouts and \$150 for new Scouts (registration, insurance, scout book, new Scout fee)
- Extra activities range from \$10 - \$30 each
- Your scout will need a "Class A" uniform. This includes the Cub Scout Shirt, neckerchief and slide for his rank, and a belt. You can purchase these items at Scout Stores located in Cleveland or Wakeman or online at [www.scoutstuff.org](http://www.scoutstuff.org). (Tip: Buying a few sizes larger minimizes your annual costs as you move to the next rank.)
- "Class B" uniform t-shirt: \$10 (optional)
- Pack Hat: \$10 (optional)

**The Pack does its best to keep costs to a minimum. We will participate in some fundraisers that support our activities and allow costs to be subsidized when possible. The largest is the Popcorn Fundraiser, which kicks off the year in September. We will explore other fundraising opportunities as necessary throughout the year.**
