Attention Students:

Plans to adjust the quantity of hours making one eligible for a community service cord have been put on hold for the 2020-2021 school year, particularly the class of 2021. Seniors graduating in 2021 will only need to log 30 community service hours by April 1 to receive the service cord. All subsequent classes beginning with the class of 2022 will need 45 hours logged by April of their senior year to receive the honor. The most hours a student can receive for a semester of being a student-aide will continue to be 30 for this year and reduce to 15 next year.



Community Service

All forms MUST be signed by an adult supervisor who can verify the hours were completed as noted and should not be a parent of the student. You can drop off hard copies to Room 195, you can ask a secretary in the main office to put it Mr. Arra's mailbox, OR you can send a .jpg or .pdf of a completed form to jeffrey.arra@avonlakecityschools.org. The email option will continue until the pandemic is over. Blank hard copies are available in the office, guidance office, or in room 195
