

ALCC Scholarship

The Avon Lake Community Council (an organization of non-profits in Avon Lake) will be awarding one \$500 scholarship to a student graduating from the Avon Lake High School (including JVS) in the graduating Class of 2026.

Who Can Apply?

The Avon Lake Community Council Scholarship is open to any graduating senior from Avon Lake High School or Lorain County JVS and who is an Avon Lake resident.

Eligibility

Applicants must complete the Common Scholarship Application including unofficial transcript and resume, through the Avon Lake High School Guidance Office. A brief essay is required.

The Avon Lake Community Council Scholarship is open to applicants of any college major and extends to any post-secondary education or pursuit of a trade including military service and first responder certification training programs. Applicants must provide proof of enrollment.

Scholarship is need-blind. Students do not need to provide documentation of financial need. However, should a student be presented with an extenuating circumstance, documentation from their counselor can be included in their application.

There is no GPA requirement.

Selection Criteria

Community involvement, leadership skills, and positive character are essential components for this scholarship.

Applicants must describe their community involvement and impact. Community involvement could include extracurricular groups, religious organizations, community service groups, volunteer work or other support.

Applicants must describe their leadership roles, what they have learned and the impact of their leadership.

Applicants should describe why they should be awarded this scholarship and must answer the question, "How did growing up in Avon Lake impact who you have become?"
