

JFSA COLLEGE FINANCIAL AID PROGRAM



JFSA administers scholarships and grants to students in the greater Cleveland area enrolled in accredited institutions of higher education. Scholarships are awarded in competition with other students who have met application requirements. Some scholarships are renewable. Grants are based on need and available funds. Funds may be used toward tuition and education fees. All students must reapply each year. Loans may be made available in some circumstances.

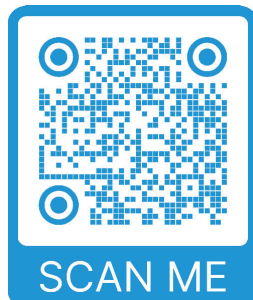
CORE PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

- High school senior, college undergraduate, or graduate student who identifies as Jewish
- Full time student
- Attending an accredited 4-year college (no online programs)
- Resident of Cuyahoga, Summit, Portage, Geauga, Medina, Lorain or Lake counties
- Has applied to or exhausted other sources and still needs additional finances to complete education
- 2.5 GPA minimum

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR MIDDLE INCOME HOUSEHOLDS

Learn about a new scholarship available for students from middle income households, funded by the Jack, Joseph and Morton Mandel Foundation. Up to \$5,000 can be awarded. Applications are processed on a competitive first-come, first-serve basis for students with a 3.0 GPA and higher.

Eligibility guidelines vary by individual scholarship.
