2026 Kenneth Hicks Memorial Scholarship Application



CommStar Credit Union created the Kenneth Hicks Memorial Scholarship to assist high school students, in our community, with financing post-secondary education. The scholarship will reward individuals who demonstrate their commitment to academics, leadership and involvement in school and community activities. Financial need may also be considered. This scholarship will be awarded in memory of Kenneth Hicks who is recognized for over 30 years of dedication, leadership and support of continuing education to our credit union.

To qualify, a student must be a high school senior attending one of the following schools: Elyria High School, Elyria Catholic High School, Lorain High School, Clearview High School, Avon Lake High School; and be in pursuit of post -secondary education including: professional, vocational and academic studies, not limited to colleges, universities or military academies.

CommStar Credit Union will award five \$1,000 scholarships and reserves the right to revise, suspend or discontinue this program without notice.

To apply:

- 1) Complete the application form.
- 2) Attach an official transcript from your high school.
- 3) Attach a letter of recommendation from a teacher or employer.
- 4) Submit a one minute video on a topic of your choice (optional).
- 5) **Applications must be received no later than February 6, 2026 at noon.**
