2026 Scholarship Application

The North Coast Chamber of Commerce awards scholarships to students who display positive character, leadership skills, academic excellence, community involvement, and future aspiration.

A total of three (3) \$1,500.00 scholarships will be awarded to seniors graduating from a member community high school (Avon, Avon Lake, and Brookside) pursuing a full-time course of study at a college, university, or vocational/technical school.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Applicants must be graduating seniors from Avon High School, Avon Lake High School or Brookside High School.
- Applicants must have a past or present work experience. This may include apprenticeships, co-op programs, summer work, part-time work, or work in a family business (even if not paid).
- Applicants must have a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5, or have shown considerable improvement in their academic performance.
- Applicants must have demonstrated community involvement. This could include religious organizations, community groups, volunteer work, or other involvement.

Funds will be disbursed directly to the college, university, or vocational/technical school.

Scholarships will be awarded at the student's high school Senior Awards Ceremony.

The NCCC reserves the right to withhold the scholarship or any portion thereof at any time it may determine it is not in the best interest of the Chamber to make such an award.
