- Learn how to earn college credit while you're still in middle school or high school.
- Qualified students can take a single course or enroll full time at Tri-C while working toward their high school diploma.
- The completed coursework counts as college and high school credit.
- Many courses at Tri-C are Transfer Assurance Guide (TAG) or Ohio Transfer 36 courses, which are guaranteed to transfer to any of Ohio's public institutions of higher education.
