Avon Lake High School is a comprehensive high school with approximately 1,300 students in grades 9-12 and has been a U.S. News and World Report Nationally Ranked High School annually since 2007. ALHS is also ranked #1 in Lorain County, and #8 in the Cleveland Region.

Our current Senior Class enrollment is 348. Lorain County JVS enrollment is 68.

A total of 21 credits is required for graduation including 4 English, 4 Math, 3 Science, 3 Social Studies, 1 Health/Physical Education, and 1 Fine Art/Business/Technology/World Language. Lorain County JVS graduates must have 4 English, 4 Math, 3 Social Studies, 3 Science and 1 Health/Physical Education.
