







Is anyone in your household employed by the Avon Lake City School District?




How familiar are you with the Building ALegacy initiative the district has been working on for the last several years?


The district is working to determine the best course of action in proceeding with a large-scale school facilities project. Which of the following statements best describe your feelings about the issue?




In addition to the facilities project, the District also needs to manage operational costs (salaries, supplies, utilities, etc.). Which of the following statements best reflects your opinion.










As decisions are being made about the future of the school district buildings, which of the following should be the most important factor used to decide what will be done?

Do you feel that the current elementary school facilities are sufficient to serve the students of Avon Lake into the future?


